YVONNE COLLIER'S CONSERVATIVES

- 1 Organised the first public meeting on the GMSF (the plan the Liberal Democrat's made us part of) to let people know about their plans for 4,000 houses in High Lane.
- 2 Marched alongside fellow High Lane residents to protest at Stockport Town Hall and Manchester Town Hall.
- 3 Protected Greenbelt land in High Lane by voting to keep us in GMSF process at this stage. Liberal Democrat plans would have meant an extra 900 houses on our Greenbelt.



THE LIBERAL DEMOCRAT CANDIDATE

- 1 Didn't attend the public meeting organised by the local Conservative team. He also didn't march with residents against his party's plans for 4,000 houses in High Lane.
- 2 Liberal Democrats voted against commencing a local plan, risking our local greenbelt for developers to rip up as they would wish.
- 3 Liberal Democrats voted to build over 300 homes on Greenbelt land in Heald Green. Thankfully Conservative/Labour Councillors voted this down.
